Honorary membership for Prof. Dr. Dr. H.C. Fred Scholz

As a scientist, Prof. Dr. Dr. H.C. Fred Scholz has worked continuously with the Sultanate of Oman for decades. He is considered one of the most knowledgeable experts in the country. However, many people do not know that he was a driving force and played a prominent role in the founding of the German-Omani Association (GOA).

Consequently the Board of the German-Omani Association has decided to bestow on him an honorary membership, which he has gladly accepted. On this occasion the Omani Ambassador to Germany, His Excellency Khalid Sulaiman Abdul Rahman Ba' Omar invited friends and companions of the honorees, as well as the Berlin-based members of the GOA, to a dinner at his residence in Berlin-Dahlem.



Prof. Dr. Heinz Gaube praised the scientific achievements of Fred Scholz, whose scientific interests as geographer were concerned especially with the Asian and Central Asian region. The focus was and has been again and again the Sultanate of Oman. Besides the urge to explore, his motivation was undoubtedly his love for the country and its people.

In a short speech Fred Scholz explained how, in the early eighties, he and Sayyid Tariq bin Taimur Al Said developed and promoted the idea of establishing a German-Omani friendship society.

This constructive role of Fred Scholz in the establishment phase of the GOA was praised by Mr Bruno Kaiser, current president of the German-Omani Association. He presented Prof. Scholz with the membership certificate, along with a bouquet of flowers for Mrs. Scholz. The ambassador underlined the high esteem which Prof. Scholz enjoys in the Sultanate, and presented him with a commemorative coin from the National Bank of Oman.

Special Exhibition "Greetings from Oman" at the Museum for Communication in Berlin

The special exhibition "Greetings from Oman" will be presented from March 5 to March 29, 2015 at the Museum for Communication in Berlin. It was initiated by our association and will be conducted in cooperation with Oman's Ministry of Tourism and the Ministry of Religious Affairs. The official opening of the exhibition will take place on March 5, 2015 at 7 PM in the atrium of the Museum for Communication (Leipziger Str 16, 10117 Berlin), in conjunction with a reception given by the Ministry of Tourism at the International Tourism Exchange (ITB) 2015. Invitations will be sent to you shortly before the event.

The exhibition includes general information about the country and people, and above all, a very interesting presentation on the postal history of the Sultanate. In addition, a new 18-language multimedia terminal will be presented for the first time in Germany at this event. It is currently being designed for the international traveling exhibition "Tolerance-Understanding-Coexistence, the message of Islam in Oman." The organization of the exhibition involves our members F.J. Pütz, J. Düster, Hatim Al Atar, H. Walther, J. Al-Maskari and K. Neubert.
